1. The Woolbridge Motor Club Ltd. will organise a Clubsport **Autotest/Slalom** (delete as applicable) on
Date _____ (enter date) **At** _____ (enter event venue)
2. Held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Permit Number – tba
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of Woolbridge Motor Club and Bournemouth & District Car Club.
5. The start and finish will be at the venue, and the programme is as follows: -
Scrutineering starts at 0930 hrs. First test at 1030 am.
Any competitor not signed on by 20 minutes before the start time may be excluded.
7. All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations in respect of both vehicle and tyre regulations. The following classes will apply: -
 - a) Saloons up to 1000cc
 - b) Saloons up to 1400cc
 - c) Saloons up to 1600cc
 - d) Saloons up to 2000cc
 - e) Saloons over 2000cc
 - f) Sports cars and convertibles (with roof down)
 - g) SpecialsConvertibles run as sports cars with hood down, otherwise as saloons. Estates run as saloons
8. Awards will be presented as follows: -
 - i) BTD - an award.
 - ii) Best performance in each class - an award.
 - iii) Second best performance in each class, subject to six or more starters - an award.
 - iv) Third best performance in each class, subject to twelve or more starters - an award.
 - v) Best performance by a Novice - an award.No competitor may receive more than one award.
9. The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations and closes finally on the Wednesday before the event **The entry fee is £20.00**. All entries must be made on the official form and be accompanied by the entry fee. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY**

15. Protests must be lodged as per O.5.116
16. Details of the tests will be given at signing on. All runs will count for results purposes. Timing will be by hand-held chronometers. The starting signal will be both verbal and visual. The order of attempting tests will be numerical.
17. Practising is not permitted.
18. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written.
19. All vehicles must meet the requirements of QA17.2 in respect of silencing.
20. Light commercial vans (e.g. minivans) may be used. Rear doors may not be removed.
21. No car may have more than two drivers.
22. Competition cars need not have a current Road Fund Licence as the event is on private land.
23. It is a competitor's responsibility to return scorecards to the timekeeper / secretary of the meeting after each round.
24. Final instructions will be issued at signing on and will not be posted. Please assume your entry has been accepted unless notified.
